



Teen Driver Education Contract

This document will serve as an agreement between E Street Driving School, the student, and the student parent(s).

General Policies:

1. Students must be *at least* 15 years old by the day they are enrolled in the course. (RCW 46.82.420)
2. Students must successfully complete 34 hours of classroom instruction (includes 4 hrs of simulator instruction), five hours of behind the wheel instruction, and up to five hours of observation.
3. Tuition must be paid in full to receive a Traffic Safety Education Certificate. Returned checks will be charge \$25.
4. Students will not be allowed to enroll after the third class period.
5. Students may withdraw from the class up to the third class period for a 75% refund. No refunds will be given after the third class period.
6. In the event of failure to complete payment, E Street Driving School, LLC, shall be entitled to attorney fees and other damages. The venue for any action shall be in the county of residence, State of Washington. An interest rate at 1.5% per month (18% per annum) will be paid on all past due accounts.
7. Lost Traffic Safety Education Certificates are reissued with a \$15.00 fee.
8. Legislation requires class instruction about organ donation options. Families may request alternate class work from an instructor during that portion of the class. (RCW 46.82.420)
9. Missed class sessions must be made up in order to maintain the concurrent order of learning. If a student misses more than three classes, they may be required to retake the course.
10. Regulations governing commercial driving schools dictate that the time from the beginning of a class to the issuing of a certificate be not less than 30 days. Students not completing within four months may enroll for another session.

Classroom Policies:

1. A student can be removed from the class for behavior problems, cheating, graffiti, defacing class materials, coming to class intoxicated or drug-induced condition. In these cases, the student will not be permitted to return and there will be no tuition refund.
2. Use of tobacco products are prohibited within 500 ft. of the E Street Driving School, LLC classroom.
3. Electronic equipment that distracts the student from the instructor’s presentation will be removed for the class period.
4. Classroom work must receive an 80% score to pass. Work below 80% can be made up as needed.

Driving Policies:

1. Families agree to provide opportunities for the student to practice driving at home to be successful in this course.
2. Drives must be cancelled online outside of 8 hours to avoid a \$25 cancellation fee.
3. Students will be charged \$25 if they do not have their learner’s permit at their scheduled drive lesson.
4. Students are expected to wait at the meeting location for at least 15 minutes after the scheduled start time.
5. Students that arrive for a drive session in an intoxicated or drug induced condition will not drive and be dropped from the course without tuition refund and will not be allowed to re-enroll. The use of tobacco products is *not allowed* while driving or riding as a passenger in the driving instruction car.
6. Once a student begins the driving phase, there will be no tuition refunds.
7. All driving skills are scored 4-excellent, 3-satisfactory, 2-not passing, 1-failed. Skills receiving a 2 or 1 will need to be practiced with the parent/guardian. During the next drive, the driving instructor will re-evaluate these skills. After the five drives are complete, any skills still receiving a 2 or 1 will require extra driving sessions at the rate of \$35 per hour.
8. Families will be responsible for providing coverage for their vehicle and permitted driver.

I agree to abide by the above conditions and guidelines. I realize that violations of these policies are grounds for dismissal from the course.

Intermediate Driver License Restrictions:

- For the first six months of driving, teen can’t have passengers under the age of 20 except for family member.
- After six month, in addition to family members, up to three passengers under age 20 can also ride in the car.
- No late night driving between 1 a.m. & 5 a.m. The intermediate driver may only drive if a parent, guardian or other driver, who is at least 25 years old ride along.
