



Teen Driver Education Contract

This document will serve as an agreement between E Street Driving School, the student, and the student parent(s).

Traffic Safety Education Policies

1. Students must be *at least* **15 years old** by the first day of the course. (RCW 46.82.420)
2. Students must successfully complete **34 hours of classroom instruction** (includes 4 hrs of simulator instruction), **five hours** of behind the wheel instruction, and **up to five hours** of observation.
3. Tuition and fees (testing, cancellation) must be paid in full to receive a Traffic Safety Education Certificate.
4. Students **will not** be allowed to enroll after the third class period.
5. Students may withdraw from the class up to the third class period for a **75% refund**. No refunds will be given after the third class period or after the driving phase has begun. **Returned checks will be charge \$50.**
6. In the event of failure to complete payment, E Street Driving School, LLC, shall be entitled to attorney fees and other damages. The venue for any action shall be in the county of residence, State of Washington. **An interest rate at 1.5% per month (18% per annum) will be paid on all past due accounts.**
7. Legislation requires class instruction about **organ donation** options. Families may request alternate class work from an instructor during that portion of the class. (RCW 46.82.420)
8. **Missed class sessions must be made up in order to maintain contiguous learning. If a student misses more than three classes, they will be required to retake the course.**
9. Students must complete drive lessons with **weekly contact** after passing the final exam.
10. Classroom work must receive an **80% score to pass**. Work below 80% can be made up as needed.
11. State law dictates that a class cannot complete in less than 30 calendar days.
12. A student can be removed from the class for behavior problems, cheating, graffiti, defacing class materials, coming to class intoxicated or drug-induced condition.
In these cases, the student will not be permitted to return and there will be no tuition refund.
13. Use of tobacco products are prohibited within 500 ft. of the E Street Driving School, LLC classroom.
14. Any equipment that distracts a student from the instructor's presentation will be removed for the class period.

Drive Policies

15. **Drives must be cancelled online outside of 24 hours to avoid a \$25 cancellation fee.**
16. **Students will be charged \$25 if they do not have their learner's permit at their scheduled drive lesson.**
17. Students are expected to wait at the meeting location for at least 10 minutes after the scheduled start time.
18. Students that arrive for a drive session in an intoxicated or drug induced condition will not drive and may be dropped from the course without tuition refund. The use of tobacco products is *not allowed* while driving or riding as a passenger in the driving instruction vehicle.
19. Student's cell phones will be placed in the center console during the entire driving lesson.
20. Student's drive lessons may be filmed for educational and training purposes.
21. All driving skills are scored **4-above average, 3-average, 2-below average, 1-needs significant improvement**. Skills receiving a 2 or 1 will need practice with the parent/guardian. The skills will be re-evaluated during the following drive. If additional drives are required, they will be billed at the rate of **\$35 per hour**.

Testing Policies

- 22. ***All testing fees are separate from tuition and DOL's application and licensing fees.**
- 23. **Written testing fees:** \$30 for 2 attempts when paid with tuition. \$25 per additional attempt. \$35 per attempt as a walk-in.
- 24. You must get a score of 80% or above to pass. Exam scores are entered within 24 hours.
- 25. The Department of Licensing reserves the right to conduct **random re-examinations**; applicants refusing to take a re-examination may have their license revoked.
- 26. If a student is caught cheating on the written test, they will not be allowed to test again at any driver training school. They will be required to test only at the Department of Licensing office.
- 27. **Driving skill test fees are paid at the time of service.** No prepayment arrangements are allowed.

Parent Responsibilities

- 28. Families agree to provide opportunities for driving practice outside of this course. (See item 21)
- 29. Families are responsible for providing coverage for their vehicle and student driver during practice time.

To qualify for a license under the age of 18, you must

- Be at least 16 years of age
- Successfully completed a traffic safety education course
- Have had your permit for at least six (6) months
- Have had fifty (50) hours driving experience with at least ten (10) night driving hours

I agree to abide by the above conditions and guidelines. I understand that violations of these policies are grounds for dismissal from the course.

Intermediate Driver License Restrictions:

- You cannot drive between 1 a.m. and 5 a.m. unless you are with a parent, a guardian, or a licensed driver who is at least 25 years old.
- For the first six months, no passenger under the age of 20 may be with you while you drive unless that person is a member of your immediate family.
- For the remaining time, no more than three passengers under the age of 20 may be with you while you drive unless they are members of your immediate family.
- May not use a cell phone or other wireless communication device while operating a motor vehicle unless the holder is using the device to report illegal activity, summon medical or other emergency help, or prevent injury to a person or property.
