



SCAMPER ' S SKILL REVIEW

Backing around a corner:

1. Pull to the side of the road just past the corner using SMOG
2. Right signal, put in reverse
3. Back up looking out your back window until the back right window corner matches your side of the sidewalk.
4. Ped stop. Look in all directions.
5. Back up further until back right window matches the curb line.
6. Turn the wheel all the way to the right and turn the corner.
7. Check right side mirror and straighten the wheel when the back of car is within 12" of the curb.
8. Set your rear RPM in your back window.

Backing out of an alley:

1. Turn into alley with SMOG, get centered.
2. Stop once into the enclosure 2-3 car lengths.
3. Set right signal and put into reverse.
4. Put left hand at 12 o'clock position on wheel and look out back window.
5. Back up carefully until the right back window matches the curb line.
6. Stop and check in all directions for peds and other cross traffic.
7. When clear, roll back until back tires drop off sidewalk, or you are sitting in the middle of the sidewalk.

8. Turn wheel hard right and back around the corner looking out your back window.
9. Straighten wheel when car is aligned with the curb.
10. Back up straight, using rear RPM.

Parallel Parking:

1. Right signal, mirror, head check and move into lane position 3.
2. Line yourself straight with the car you are parking behind.
3. Stop when the back left corner of the car you're parking behind matches you back right window corner.
4. Change gear to reverse.
5. Turn wheel hard to the right and back up to 45 degrees.
6. Straighten wheel and back up until right side mirror is matched with the back left corner of the car you're parking behind.
7. Turn wheel hard to the left and back yourself in towards the curb.
8. Stop car when you are parallel with the curb.
9. Assess for being centered.
10. Back up, or move forward until centered.
11. Secure vehicle.

Head check
